

CLEMENTINE SAFETY

It is mandatory that docents when supervising visitors who are entering and exiting the F-8 Crusader exercise extreme caution and follow the established steps below
As the supervisor, be on the platform and ready to catch or grab ahold in case of lost balance or a fall. Do **NOT** give directions while standing on the hangar deck, be on the platform. Caution the visitor to see that his/her head does not hit the canopy overhead.

Then give the following directions:

1. **right foot on the yellow step** and grab ahold of the cockpit for balance
2. **left foot on the protruding step** from the fuselage
3. **lift your right foot and step onto the SEAT**, not the floorboard
4. step up with the **other foot onto the seat**
5. then **sit down**.

When exiting be sure you caution visitor about hitting the head on the canopy. Inform them to reverse the directions given earlier.

1. stand up on the seat facing forward
2. place left hand on edge of canopy
3. lower left foot onto the side step
4. swing right foot over side of cockpit towards you and lower to yellow step
5. grab onto railing when going down steps to deck.

As supervisor be sure you extend your left arm out and behind visitor while they are exiting. Do NOT touch them but have arm in such a way that you can possibly prevent them from falling.
